- Over 2.7 million passengers travelled to and from Dublin Airport in April. The number of passengers travelling through Dublin Airport in April was up 1% on last year.
- Essential maintenance works were scheduled to take place from Monday, May 13 to Thursday, May 16 from 11pm to 5am, inclusive. Due to low visibility procedures (LVP), works could not proceed on Monday, May 13. This will now be deferred to Friday, May 17. All maintenance works are subject to weather conditions. The next scheduled works will take place in July.
- Notification of maintenance works is now published on Webtrak as well as communicated through the normal channels.
- To facilitate extra passenger and aircraft parking demand due to the UEFA Europa League Final, North Runway will be closed at 6pm on Wednesday, May 22 and will reopen at 7am on Thursday May 23. South Runway will be used for take-off and landing whilst the North Runway will be used for aircraft parking. There will be an increase of aircraft movements to facilitate demand, particularly between 2am and 5am on Thursday, May 23. We aim to depart as many aircraft as possible before 3:30am.
- Recently RedC Research conducted a door-to-door survey across areas in Fingal to assess community sentiment and obtain feedback in relation to Dublin Airport operations and activities. Results will be circulated and published in the coming weeks.
- The Community Fund has closed for applications with the Grant Making Panel meeting taking place in early June after which the successful applicants will be contacted. The Community Fund is currently undertaking a review and any changes and updates will be advised at the next CLG meeting.

Noise Complaints & Noise Reporting

Noise Complaint Management System Features

- Complaint Handling Policy was updated in 2023 providing details such as:
- Options for lodging a complaint telephone, website, Webtrak, post
- Reporting procedures
- How responses will be dealt with and issued
- System underwent an upgrade in Dec 2023/ Jan 2024 and continues to be reviewed:
- Registration process to streamline process after an initial submission.
- Telephone voice message with automated transcription.
- New complaint form now suitable for smartphone.
- A database management system is in place to effectively manage complaints:
- ANOMS is the world leading software for airport noise monitoring systems, noise reporting, flight tracker technology and complaint management system. Used by 80+ worldwide airports.
- It stores data on aircraft movements, flight tracks, and noise monitors.
- Individual flights can be linked to a complaint in the ANOMS system.
- As a result of these changes:

December 2023: Backlog 33,000 complaints 3,000 voice recordings – inbox full



May 2024: 500 complaints awaiting response Voice recording working well

Noise Reporting

- 2024 public noise reporting consists of:
 - Monthly Noise and Operations Reports
 - Quarterly Noise and Flight Track Monitoring Reports
- Monthly Noise and Operations Report provides data on:
 - o Dublin Airport operations including movements and runway use
 - Noise Complaints
- Quarterly Noise Monitoring Reports provides data from noise monitoring terminals
- Q1 2024 report currently being reviewed for compliance with Fingal County Council
- Both reports have been reformatted and updated with the aim of:
 - Responding to community feedback on their need for more information
 - Providing further data and information relating to monthly airport operations
 - Providing data in a primarily graphical format to aid understanding of the information
 - Reducing information provision which communities deem not to be useful in terms of their understanding of the noise situation surrounding Dublin Airport
- Further refinements and updates may be made over the coming months to further improve the data offering to local communities and the wider public
- Feedback from CLG members on how we can further improve these reports is welcome






Monthly Aircraft Movements YTD + 2023

Windrose Dublin Apt March 2024









Proposal to address complaints received out of process

14 May 2024 **OrbinAirport**

- A template letter was recently circulated in the public domain in relation to the noise complaint system
- Key ask: to log every single flight off North Runway on the system (small number requested other runway operations)
- 57 letters/emails received in total (majority during the month of March)
- If reported based on departures from NR:
 - 4,747 departures in March x 57 = 270,579 total complaints in March 2024
 - Assume 62,368 departures in year 2024 x 57 = 3,554,976 complaints / year
- Key issues:
 - None logged into the formal complaints process (ANOMS)
 - Missing detail 40 of 57 without Eircode, 19 of 57 with incomplete address (e.g. The Ward).
 - Assumptions have to be made on occupancy of homes 365 days a year, 7am – 11pm.
- Proposal:
 - We will continue to accept complaints made only through the formal complaints system (ANOMS).
 - We will acknowledge the 57 complaint letters received and will reference these bulk complaints in the March and/or April report.

Dear Ms Flynn

I am writing to you to inform you that the Noise Complaint system at Dublin Airport is not fit for purpose.

Since the opening of the North Runway in August 2022, aircraft have been flying in the vicinity of my home which they were never planned to do and the environmental impacts of this unplanned flight path were never assessed or presented in the planning application which received permission in 2007.

Therefore every flight off the North Runway is a noise problem for me and my family. For us to use the complaints system we would have to spend all of our time between 7am and 11pm submitting these complaints. This is not practical.


I would therefore request that you log every flight off the North Runway as a complaint from me and I expect these complaints to be counted and acknowledged in the complaint system.

I have to live my life under the stress of the aircraft noise and this is bad enough without having to spend all day using your system to log a complaint. It is just not possible.

Thank you for your understanding on this matter and trust you will include my noise complaints.







